Welcome to the 2009 camping season! We are ready to offer another fun-filled summer of fishing, boating, arts and crafts, music and drama, talent shows and overnight camping.

Camp Haccamo is a resident camp for individuals with disabilities 7-28 years of age. We accept individuals with a wide range of disabilities and have an adapted program to accommodate many needs. Our staff comes from a variety of human service fields and college programs which are preparing them for a career in human service. We offer professionally prepared meals, 24 hour nursing services and a highly qualified counselor staff.

This year, Camp Haccamo will be operating at two different locations, depending on age group. Campers aged 7-17 will attend camp at the Rotary Sunshine Campus in Rush for two one week sessions. Those two weeks will be August 3<sup>rd</sup>- 7<sup>th</sup> and August 10<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>. Adults 18-28 will be attending their camp sessions July 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> and July 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> at the Camp Haccamo site in Penfield.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## about the application

### **Application Directions**

- Complete the requested information in each section carefully and completely
- Parts 1 & 2 and the medical history form must be completed by a Parent, Guardian or Advocate.
- **Documentation of Disability must be included.** A copy of the most recent IEP, 504 Plan, OR a document with the medical diagnosis and physician's signature will be accepted.
- IEPs and Behavior Plans must be included to help us serve the camper better.
- The physical examination form must be completed by the doctor's office. The physical examination must be within one year of camper attendance.

### A. Camper registration and acceptance is complete only when:

- A complete, signed application is received in our office.
- A self-addressed business-sized stamped envelope is included.
- The Physical Form, Documentation of Disability, and Record of Immunizations are received.
- You have received written confirmation from the Camp Haccamo office. Please do not assume acceptance. Contact us if acceptance/confirmation letter is not received.

### B. Sessions have age limitations:

- Camp Management will place campers according to availability and individual preferences. However, first choice is not guaranteed.
- Camper slots are available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Camp Haccamo does not provide 1:1 aides for campers.
